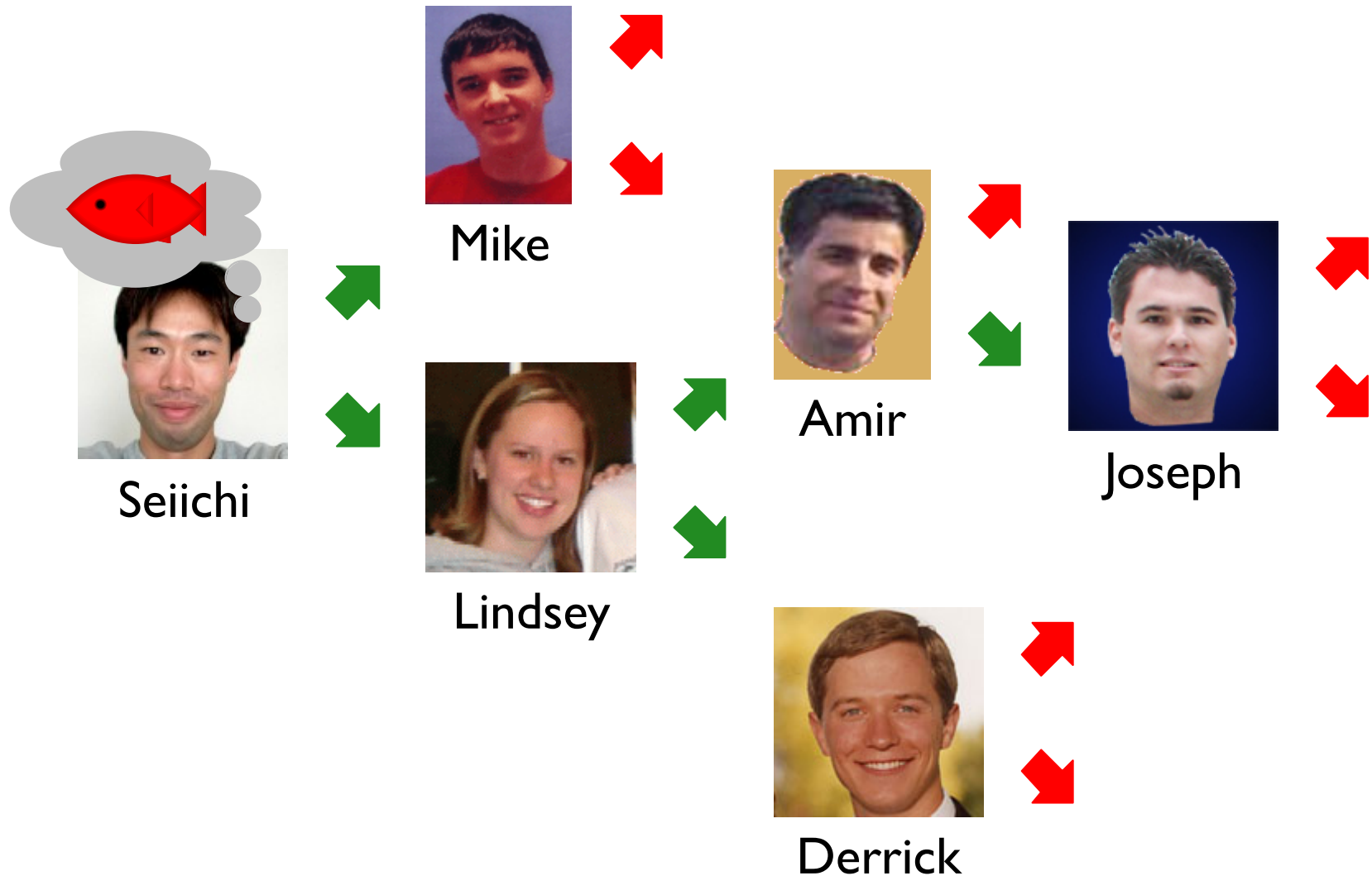
# Tracking Rumors

Simplifying assumption: each person tells at most two others



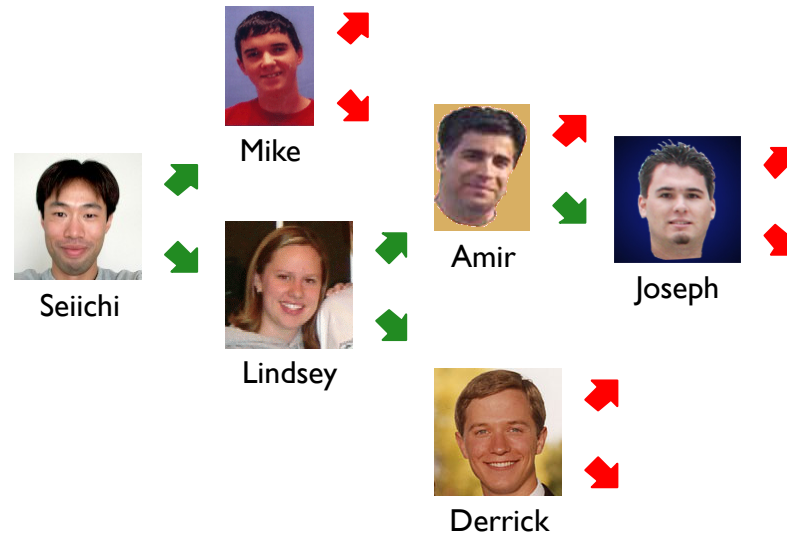

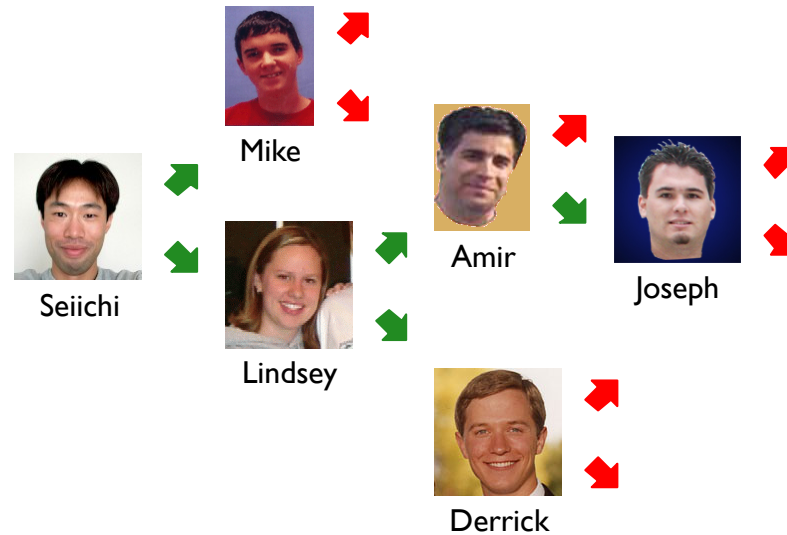


# Representing Rumor Mills
